Welcome to our Winter Reading program! Here are some rules for your bingo card.

- ✓ **This game piece is for children between the ages of 8-12 years old.**
There is a separate game pieces for children ages 2-7. Because of this, the books you read to complete your game piece must be suited for your reading level.
- ✓ **Every time you fill out a square with a star, come into the library for a SPECIAL TREAT. Filled out all three star squares? Stop by for ANOTHER prize!**
- ✓ Each time you read a book that fulfills one of the squares, let a librarian know and you'll get to mark it off your game piece!
- ✓ Once you've completed BINGO! by filling in a row of three books (diagonally, horizontally, or vertically) you get a super cool prize.
- ✓ Each space represents a separate book. You cannot use the same book to fill up more than one square.
- ✓ If you want to keep playing, you can get another prize for filling out EVERY SPACE on your game piece.
- ✓ Make sure you keep your game piece some place special, because every registered participant in Winter Reading only gets one.
- ✓ Remember to ask a librarian if you need help finding any books that can complete a square.
